We're given boldness so we can move boldly

The second portion of the disciple's prayer in Acts 4 is to ask God to do God-size things in and through them. After this prayer the place where they were meeting was shaken! Their expectation of the Holy Spirit was so bold and big that the Holy Spirit showed up and literally shook them! They were asking God to move through their city and in the lives of their neighbors and that he'll empower them to be bold as they actively participate in the movement.

We should be asking God to do big things; ground-shaking things! But we're often weighed down in asking God to do small things, asking him to do things that serve our purposes, first.

Has there been a time in your life when you experienced a "God moment" where God gave you what you needed, and you did something significant for Him?

Sometimes we don't expect Him to do much at all. God invites us to ask and expect big things from him as he advances the message of Jesus, and he expects us to respond by moving boldly into uncomfortable places armed with a deeper sense of trust.
